Nimenrix	Meningococcal ACWY
Prevenar 13	Pneumococcal
MMR II OR Priorix	Measles, mumps, rubella
Bexsero	Meningococcal B [†]  Give age-appropriate paracetamol before this vaccine
12 months Infanrix OR Tripacel	Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis
Priorix Tetra OR Proquad	Measles, mumps, rubella, varicella
ACT-HIB	Haemophilus influenzae type b
18 months Infanrix-IPV OR Quadracel	Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio
4 years
