YOUTH OFFICER PRE-EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

The Circles in the Sand Pre-Employment Program is a joint initiative between Youth Justice NSW and the AH&MRC.

Circles in the Sand has been designed to give practical skills and workplace experience to Aboriginal People, who are interested in gaining a rewarding Career as a Youth Officer at Youth Justice NSW.



Youth Officers provide direct supervision and daily care to young people in custody. They work in teams to help our young people change their behaviour and gain new skills to prevent reoffending.

Youth Officers use positive role modelling and encourage participation in daily activities like education, work, recreation, and therapy, based on individual plans. They also assess risks and handle challenging behaviours to keep the workplace safe.
